III. Minutes

a. Minutes of February 23, 2016

Tom Rushin made a motion for approval. Bryan Peltzer seconded. The motion Passed with a voice vote of 5-0.

IV. Consent Agenda

a. Agua Fria Union 005BRG Supplemental
