**RE:** June 2019 School Facilities Board Meeting Recap

At today's June 2019 Arizona School Facilities Board meeting, the Board approved \$17.7 Million in Building Renewal Grant funding to 41 Arizona K-12 School Districts covering 70 separate projects to correct facilities deficiencies. Many of the awards were for roofing, HVAC, plumbing, and weatherization of surfaces projects.

The Board also approved 6 Adjacent Ways validations performed by SFB staff for 5 school districts.

The Board's actions provide funding needed to ensure Arizona's students have adequate facilities to foster a creative learning environment. Districts are encouraged to apply for BRG funding if deficiencies exist. The next Board meeting will be held on June 26<sup>th</sup> (for July).

## About the Arizona School Facilities Board

Created in 1998, the Arizona School Facilities Board (AZSFB) is a cabinet-level, state-government agency managing \$350 Million in state funding appropriated for K-12 school district facilities. The 10-member board meets monthly to grant financing for new school construction and funding to renew existing school facilities. AZSFB staff is a partner and advocate for school districts in facilitating successful grant requests.
