

## Statewide Government Furlough Program

Laws 2010, Seventh Special Session, Chapter 3 implements a statewide government furlough program. The statewide government furlough program will involve the partial closure of state government for a specific number of days over the next two fiscal years. State employees will be on unpaid leave during such closures.

All state agencies, boards and commissions are required to participate in the statewide government furlough program, except those specifically exempted by the legislation and agency functions or services exempted by the Department of Administration.

The state designated furlough days are as follows:

### **FY 2011**

Friday, July 23, 2010  
Friday, August 20, 2010  
Friday, September 17, 2010  
Friday, November 26, 2010  
Thursday, December 23, 2010  
Friday, June 10, 2011

### **FY 2012**

Friday, July 22, 2011  
Friday, August 19, 2011  
Friday, September 16, 2011  
Friday, November 25, 2011  
Friday, December 23, 2011  
Friday, June 15, 2012

On the above mentioned furlough days, most state government offices will be closed.
