

APS Approved for Offering \$20 Million in Incentive Funds to Schools

Following is an announcement from APS for the districts within their service areas.

On September 9, 2009, the Arizona Corporation Commission approved a new APS schools offering which will allow schools (publicly funded, K-12 facilities) to reserve up to a total of \$20,000,000 of incentive funds through December 31, 2009.

New school photovoltaic systems installed within the APS retail service territory and tied to the APS grid can receive a one-time incentive from APS of up to \$2.25 per Watt DC-STC, up to a maximum incentive of 50 percent of the system cost. The standard maximum up-front incentive cap of \$75,000 has been waived for this program.

This funding will be allocated on a first come, first reserved basis.
