Why use it when we don't need to?

Waterless urinals are a great way to save water!

- *Waterless urinals, that meet industry standards, have been scientifically proven to be more hygienic than flushed urinals, to the satisfaction of numerous public health agencies.*
- *Each waterless urinal in an Arizona school can save an average of 40,500 gallons of water in one year. That's equivalent to the total amount of water consumed by one person for six full months!*
- *Applying that level of water conservation, each of the two waterless urinals installed in the School Facilities Board men's room will save the State of Arizona \$209.63 each year on its water bill!*
- *Each waterless urinal in an Arizona school can save enough on a school district's water bill to pay for itself in approximately 2 years.*
- *Waterless urinals are eligible points in the water-efficiency category for LEED™ certification.*
