RE: July 2019 School Facilities Board Meeting Recap

At today's July 2019 Arizona School Facilities Board meeting (held in June), the Board approved \$1.57 Million in Building Renewal Grant funding to 46 Arizona K-12 School Districts covering 76 separate projects to correct facilities deficiencies. The majority of awards were for roofing, HVAC, plumbing, and weatherization of surfaces projects.

The Board also approved 10 Adjacent Ways validations performed by SFB staff for 6 school districts.

The Board's actions provide funding needed to ensure Arizona's students have adequate facilities to foster a creative learning environment. Districts are encouraged to apply for BRG funding if deficiencies exist. The next Board meeting will be held on August 7, 2019.

About the Arizona School Facilities Board

Created in 1998, the Arizona School Facilities Board (AZSFB) is a cabinet-level, state-government agency managing nearly \$300 Million in state funding appropriated for K-12 school district facilities. The 10-member board meets monthly to grant funding for new school construction and to renew existing school facilities. AZSFB staff is a partner and advocate for school districts in facilitating successful grant requests.
