The ADM yield factor is calculated by dividing the district's FY 2018 100-day ADM by the number of existing housing units in that district as of the middle of the fiscal year (December 31, 2017). Due to lack of data for the housing units built during July 1 - December 31 of 2017, the ADM yield factor for Casa Grande ESD, Casa Grande UHSD, and Toltec ESD cannot be computed.
