Although I still believe the issue including costs should be borne by TUSD, in the spirit of partnership and moving this issue forward, I am authorizing TDOT to contribute 25% up to \$70k towards this project. I am not sure if an IGA is necessary or if there are costs that can be funded directly by TDOT, but will leave that to you and Diana A. to figure out. Good Morning,

I wanted to follow up on the final issue still outstanding. This is the funding contribution from the City. The conceptual cost estimate is \$279,109, this includes a 20% contingency (\$46,520).

The traffic calming project provides a great benefit to the City, in a high pedestrian corridor. In summary, to date Tucson Unified has funded the design and traffic impact analysis for the project.

As previously discussed, we would like to construct over the winter break with our contractor Sunland Asphalt.
