Warranty: Sealcoating asphalt pavement protects it from sun, oxidation, weather, water and improves friction for drivers. Items not considered to be warranty repairs include but are not limited to, damage from snow blowers, snowplows, shovels, chemicals, tree sap, traffic, patches, power steering turns, new and reopened cracks or abuse. Sealcoating around edges where asphalt meets concrete like drains, islands, curbing and sidewalks does not fix existing problems from sinking asphalt. This will prevent further damage from happening to the base that is already defected, if perimeter is maintained regularly. Alligator cracks that are requested to be crack-sealed are a temporary fix because the base underneath is likely failing. Crack-sealing these areas will not stop asphalt problems and cracks will eventually shine back through area.

A FINANCE CHARGE will be assessed if accounts are not paid when due. In the event that payment is not made in full to OnSite Asphalt, OnSite Asphalt shall be entitled to all of its costs, including attorney and lien fees, in connection with the enforcement of this contract. This estimate price is good for 30 days, we will have to re-evaluate pricing after that.

Property Damage Release: It is the owner(s), manager(s) or the signer of this proposals responsibility to ensure all fragile, breakable or potential damageable items that can be moved from asphalt surface are removed from the safety-working zone area (ex. Vehicles/Trailers, Portable Basketball Hoops or items that pertain to your business/home). The safety-working zone should be considered any area within 20' of the nearest asphalt surface. Any potential hazard(s) shall be communicated to the foreman on duty prior to starting the project. Signing this proposal releases OnSite Asphalt from any damage within the safety working zone and all legal costs associated with the proposed project.
