RE: Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (HAWK) at W. Buckeye Road, east of 33rd Avenue

Dear Murphy Elementary School District,

This letter establishes the understanding between the Murphy Elementary School District ("District") and the City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department ("Streets Department") regarding a pedestrian hybrid beacon (HAWK) requested by the District at the location of West Buckeye Road, east of 33rd Ave, in Phoenix, AZ.

The District has expressed willingness to cover the full construction cost of this HAWK. The Streets Department is amenable to proceed with this request, under the following roles and responsibilities:

The City of Phoenix will:

- Conduct design services, at the City's expense, for the improvements and provide a construction cost estimate.
- Prepare an Intergovernmental Agreement for review by the District, specifying the construction cost estimate as a not-to-exceed funding obligation by the District.
- Upon execution of the Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") and receipt of funds, complete construction of the project.
- Upon completion of the project, provide a final cost accounting and refund of any portion of the cost contribution not expended.

The District will:

- Provide its acknowledgment of the terms specified in this letter by signing and returning this letter to the Streets Department.
- Review and execute the IGA, following a good faith review and negotiation of the terms.
- Provide funding to the City of Phoenix, per the terms of the IGA.

Once the District acknowledges the respective roles and responsibilities set forth in this letter by signing and returning the letter to the undersigned, the Streets Department will begin engineering design for a HAWK at the requested location at its sole expense. This letter sets forth the general understanding of the parties and does not form a binding commitment on either party. This letter will not waive any rights on the part of the City or the District.
