RE: January 2020 School Facilities Board Meeting Recap

At today's January 2020 Arizona School Facilities Board meeting, the Board approved <u>\$7,548,722</u> in Building Renewal Grant (BRG) funding to <u>18</u> Arizona K-12 School Districts covering <u>32</u> separate projects to correct facilities deficiencies. Most awards were for plumbing and roofing projects.

The balance remaining in the BRG Fund for FY 2020 is **\$10,586,755**. The board also approved **1** Adjacent Ways validation performed by SFB staff for one school district.

The Board's actions provide funding needed to ensure Arizona's students have safe facilities that foster a creative learning environment. The SFB encourages Districts to apply for BRG funding if deficiencies exist.

The next Board meeting will be held on February 5, 2020 at the regular location in the State Capitol Building.

About the Arizona School Facilities Board

Created in 1998, the Arizona School Facilities Board (AZSFB) is a cabinet-level, state-government agency managing nearly \$300 Million in state funding appropriated for K-12 school district facilities. The 10-member board meets monthly to grant funding for new school construction and to correct deficiencies at existing school facilities. AZSFB staff is a partner and advocate for school districts in facilitating successful grant requests.
