**RE:** Update on Procurement Requirements

Beginning July 1, school districts must obtain three (3) written vendor quotes for any scope of work costing between \$10,000 and \$100,000. Verbal quotes are no longer acceptable between these limits per recently released Arizona Auditor General rule changes to the <u>Uniform System of Financial</u> Records (USFR).

The Auditor General rules on procurement are now aligned with SFB requirements for procurement of BRG projects. The SFB adopted a policy requiring three (3) written quotes within those limits on September 6, 2017.

SFB staff urges all school districts to review their own procurement policy to ensure it is in alignment with the SFB requirements and the new Auditor General rule changes to the USFR.
