RE: ACTION REQUIRED: Counties must have SFB Online Profile to Receive Payment Notification

SFB funding awards are remitted to a school district's county treasurer. When the SFB releases funds, a payment notification email is generated and sent to the county treasurer. If the county treasurer email address in the SFB's system is invalid, the county will not receive the important notification.

It's crucial that each county maintain valid contact information on file with the SFB.

If you are a county employee responsible for handling SFB funds, you must create your own account profile on the SFB website <u>and then choose to receive the notification</u>. Here's how:

- 1. Visit www.azsfb.gov and click DISTRICT ACCESS
- 2. Click CREATE ACCOUNT
- 3. Fill in all required fields then click REGISTER
- 4. Once registered, change your password and login to your account
- 5. Under MAIN, click USER PROFILE then check the box next to each 'County Transfer Notification' and click 'SAVE SELECTED'

It's vital that counties receive the email notifying them SFB funds are available for district use. Please make sure you receive this important, time-sensitive information by registering today.
