RE: November 2019 School Facilities Board Meeting Recap

At today's November 2019 Arizona School Facilities Board meeting, the Board approved <u>\$12,657,682</u> in Building Renewal Grant (BRG) funding to <u>61</u> Arizona K-12 School Districts covering <u>126</u> separate projects to correct facilities deficiencies. The majority of awards were for HVAC and roofing projects.

The Board also approved <u>4</u> Adjacent Ways validations performed by SFB staff; one each for four school districts.

The Board's actions provide funding needed to ensure Arizona's students have safe facilities that foster a creative learning environment. The SFB encourages Districts to apply for BRG funding if deficiencies exist. The next Board meeting will be held on December 11, 2019 at the Madison School District in Phoenix. The start time is different than normal, the meeting will begin at 11 AM.

About the Arizona School Facilities Board

Created in 1998, the Arizona School Facilities Board (AZSFB) is a cabinet-level, state-government agency managing nearly \$300 Million in state funding appropriated for K-12 school district facilities. The 10-member board meets monthly to grant funding for new school construction and to correct deficiencies at existing school facilities. AZSFB staff is a partner and advocate for school districts in facilitating successful grant requests.
