RE: May 2019 School Facilities Board Meeting Recap

At today's May 2019 Arizona School Facilities Board meeting, the Board approved \$7.5 Million in grant funding to 46 Arizona school Districts covering 84 separate projects for school buildings renewal and/or to correct facilities deficiencies.

The Board's actions provide funding needed to ensure Arizona's students have adequate facilities to foster a creative learning environment.

About the Arizona School Facilities Board

Created in 1998, the Arizona School Facilities Board (AZSFB) is a cabinet-level, state-government agency managing \$350 Million in state funding appropriated for K-12 school district facilities. The 10-member board meets monthly to grant financing for new school construction and funding to renew existing school facilities. AZSFB staff is a partner and advocate for school districts in facilitating successful Building Renewal Grant requests.
