RE: Teacher Transition Survey

SFB staff encourages District teachers to take this 8-minute survey conducted by Innovative Learning Environments and Teacher Change (ILETC). It's an Australian-based project with global implications. Information from ILETC is below as is a link to the survey.

The ILETC project has just released a new survey for teachers called the *Teacher Transition Survey*. The aim of the survey is to understand educators' perspectives on their transition from traditional learning spaces into more innovative learning environments. The questions ask about the types of spaces educators have worked in, the impact of physical spaces on their teaching, and what is important in supporting them transitioning from traditional to more innovative spaces. The survey only takes 8 minutes to complete.

This survey will help to inform subsequent policy and practices in school design and teacher professional development. The data will also help the project develop resources for teachers to effectively use learning spaces in schools to affect student learning. Complete the survey HERE.
