Thanks to Morenci Unified Superintendent Dr. David Woodall for sharing his 'very positive experience' with the SFB regarding several projects at Fairbanks Middle School.

The School Facilities Board approved BRGs for windows, roofing, doors, and fire alarms for Fairbanks (500 students). According to Dr. Woodall, SFB Liaison Abhi Gandhi was extremely helpful at on-site, pre-construction meetings and in assisting with grant approvals. By working quickly, Abhi helped free up hundreds of hours for Morenci facilities staff that had been spent sealing leaky windows, patching roofs, repairing broken doors and responding to false alarms, per Dr. Woodall.
