RE: Reminder about SFB Rooftop Solar Systems Policy

SFB staff reminds all Arizona school districts who have solar systems at any of their facilities to read the Board's Rooftop Solar Systems Policy and follow the required guidelines.

The policy was adopted on February 6, 2019. SFB staff has allowed districts time to prepare before the Board begins enforcing the guidelines on July 1, 2019. After July 1, failure to follow the guidelines in the Rooftop Solar Systems Policy may result in additional expense to districts applying for Building Renewal Grants involving their solar systems.
